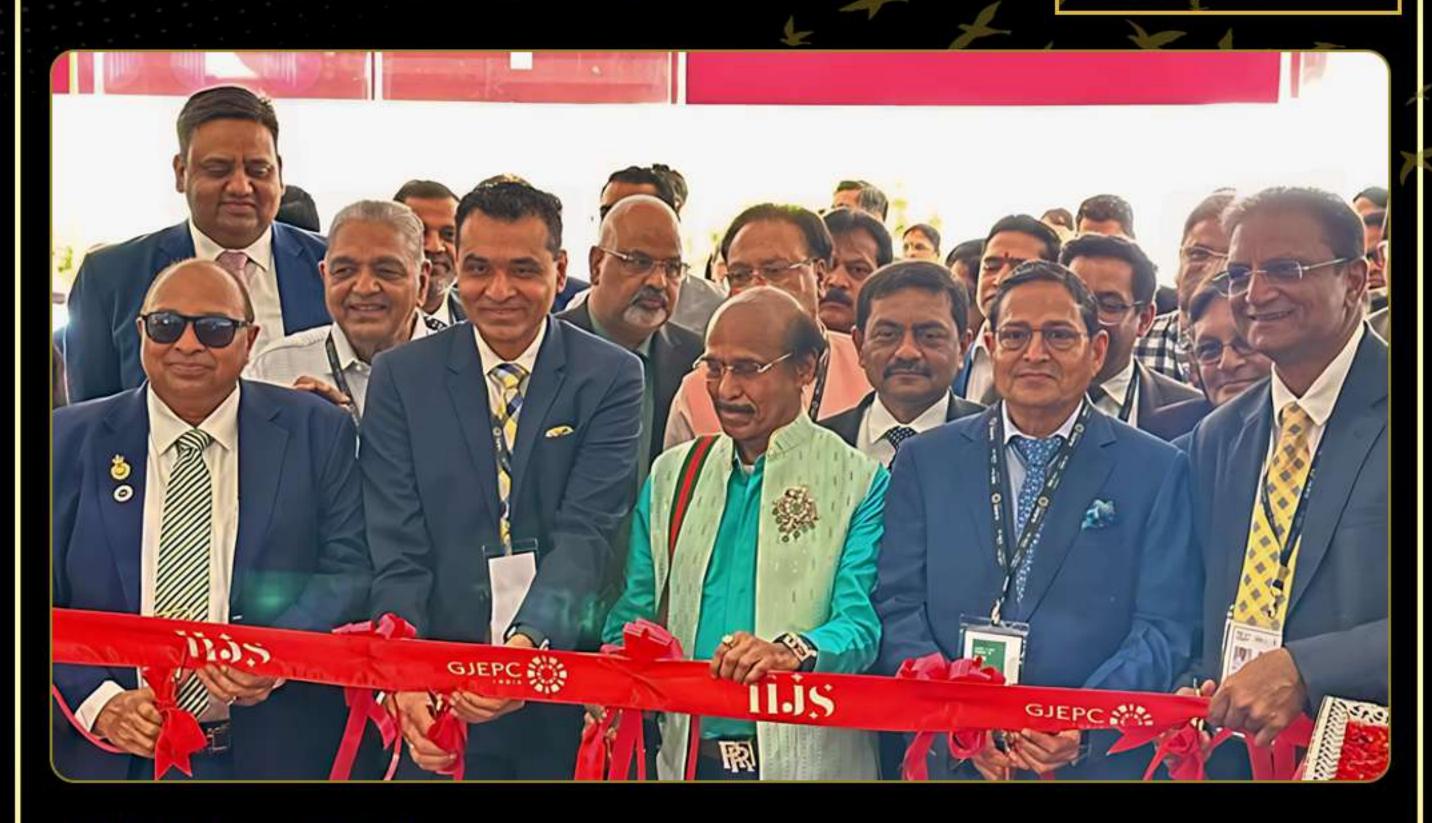


IIJS TRITIYA 2024 OPENS IN BENGALURU

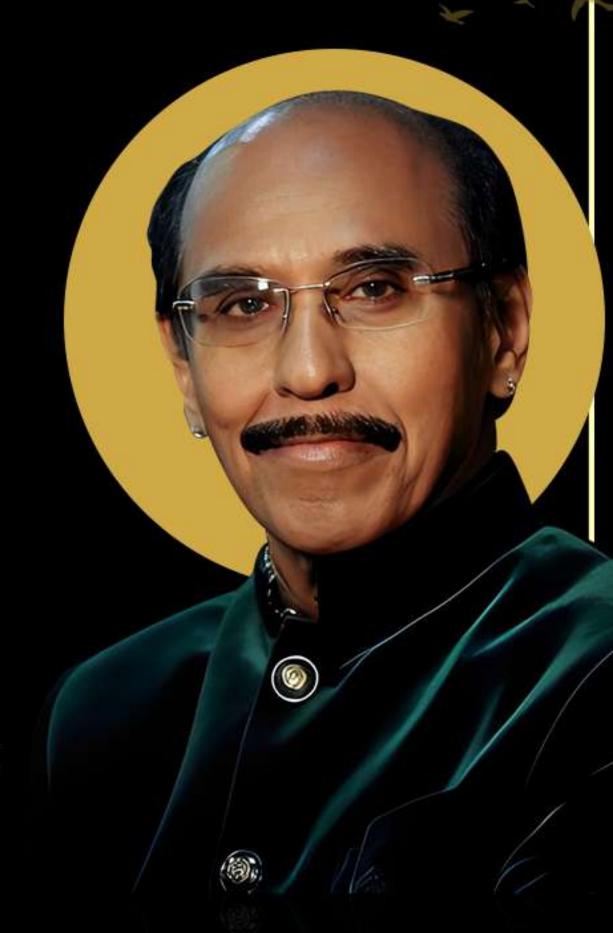

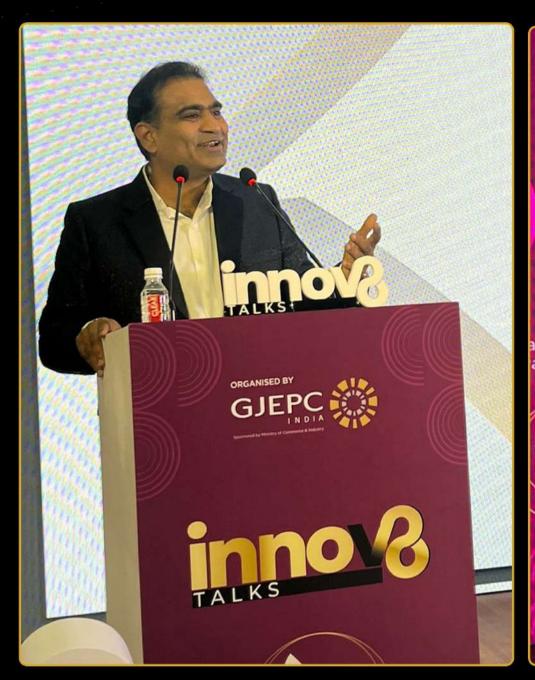


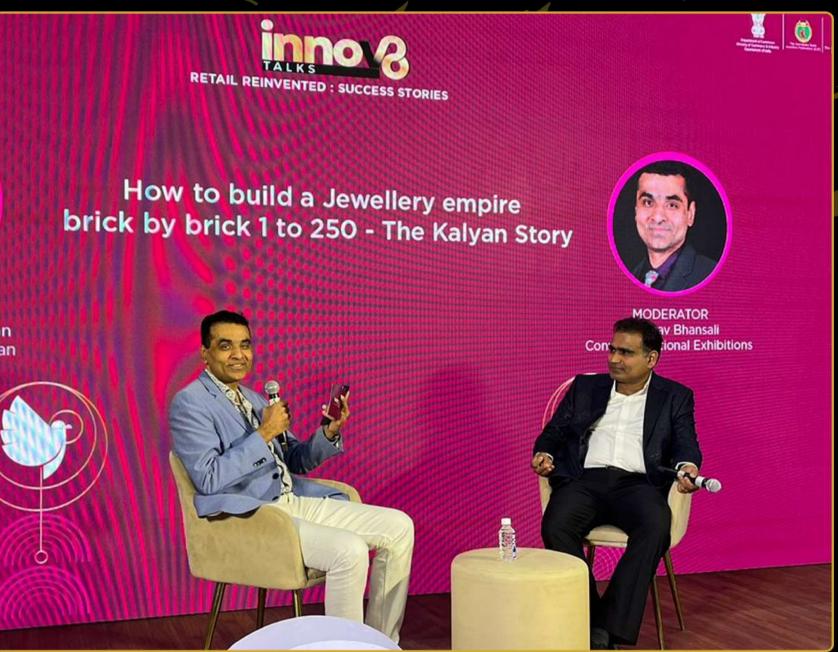


HOW TO BUILD A JEWELLERY EMPIRE BRICK BY BRICK - 1 TO 250:THE KALYAN STORY

The story commences with T S Kalyanaraman transitioning from textiles to jewellery- and then conquering the glittering jewellery sector. TS Kalyanaraman was focussed: organising the jewellery segment, and operating in a transparent and honest manner.

Kalyan Jewellers leveraged the understanding of consumer behaviour, the importance of hyperlocal strategy mixed with a pan-India strategy, the power of branding and marketing using national and regional brand ambassadors, leverage reach and impact of social media-the list of Kalyan's growth and expansion is awe-inspiring.

Transparency and service were paramount: The company is a pioneer in introducing detailed price tags. It also introduced the concept of neighbourhood customer service centers in the jewellery industry under 'My Kalyan' brand.

Kalyan Jewellers' plans to increase the contribution of its Candere brand to its bottomline by adding more physical stores. I have been fortunate to work with stalwarts at GJEPC who helped at every step. I have been fortunate that during my two tenures we have held the WDC, initiated Mega CFC, IJPM, IJEX etc. My goals are to take industry from \$40bn to \$75bn. When the world thinks of GJ, INDIA should be top of the mind. My dream is to bring all our industry associations together and create a giant umbrella organization— and speak with one united voice.

My journey at my company Asian Star was difficult and challenging- I came in as the family business amicable separated. While we knew about purchasing rough and manufacturing, we were clueless about marketing and doing global business. I was fortunate to be guided and mentored in creating a global network of clients. It was tough, but a rewarding journey. I had an aggressive, risk taking appetite. Here again I was guided by my uncle to balance it with conservative opinions of others.

My business style is to take quick decisions—and not keep issues lingering.

And I am in a hurry to implement the decision once it is taken.
